Set up a membership table/booth at all your functions.
Consider combining both local and state memberships into one fee.
Give building/site representatives training in effective ways to recruit new members.
Offer incentives to building/site representatives for 100% participation.
Use faculty senates to provide information to professionals.
Send thank you notes when appropriate. Little touches of personalization help establish good rapport.
Always include your local council name and number on all membership brochures.
Submit required correspondence for membership awards according to established auidelines.
